

Public Notice
Water Levels and Boat Launching
on Marmion Reservoir

Due to drought conditions on the Upper Marmion (Upper Floodwaters) and Lower Marmion Reservoirs, the public is advised that water levels are significantly lower than typical for this time of year.

Due to these low water conditions, the Marmion Divider Sluice will not be open for navigation until this drought period ends and the reservoirs return to seasonal levels.

Anglers wishing to access Upper Marmion (Upper Floodwaters) are advised that boat launching at Upper Seine Bay and Reserve Island landings will be difficult. The landing at Raft Lake is accessible.
